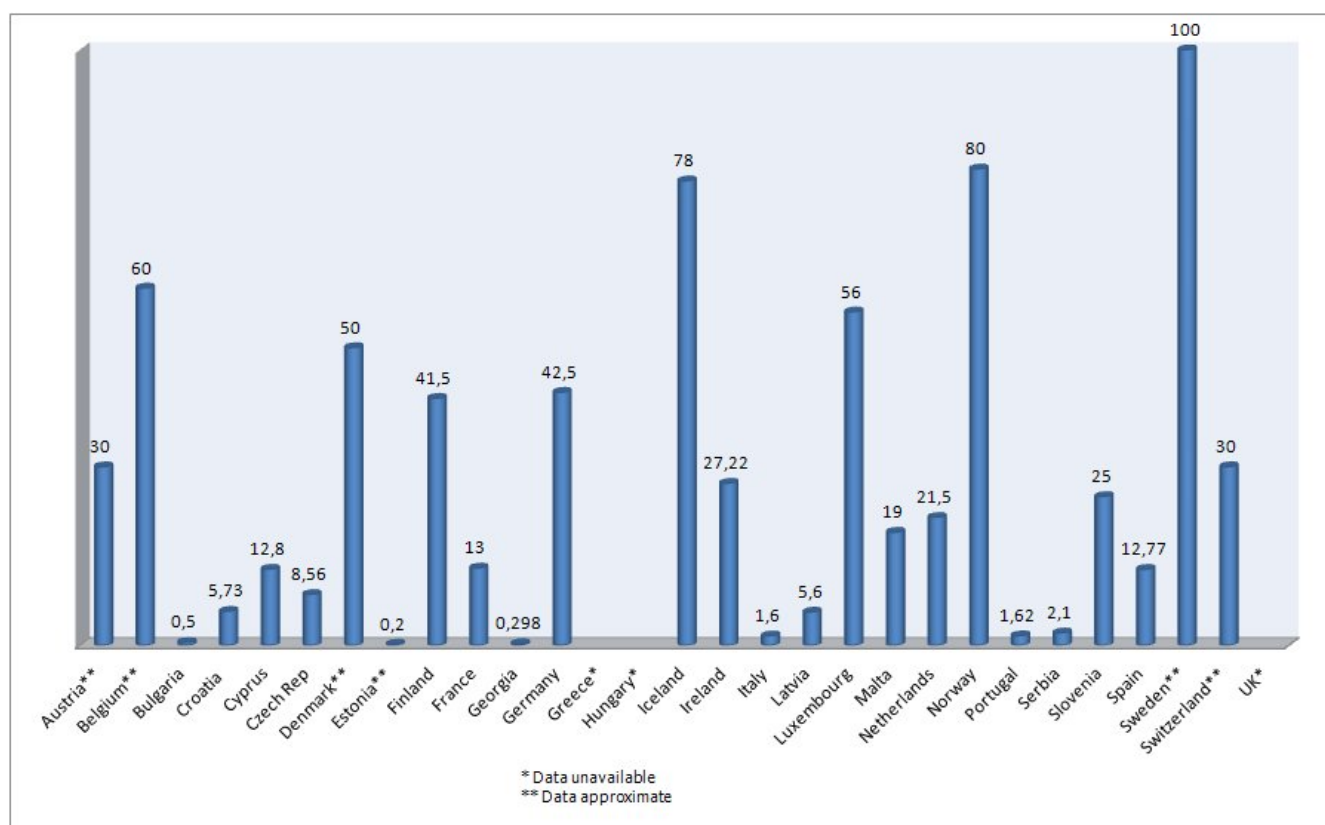


Table 1. Number of practising OT's per 100,000 head

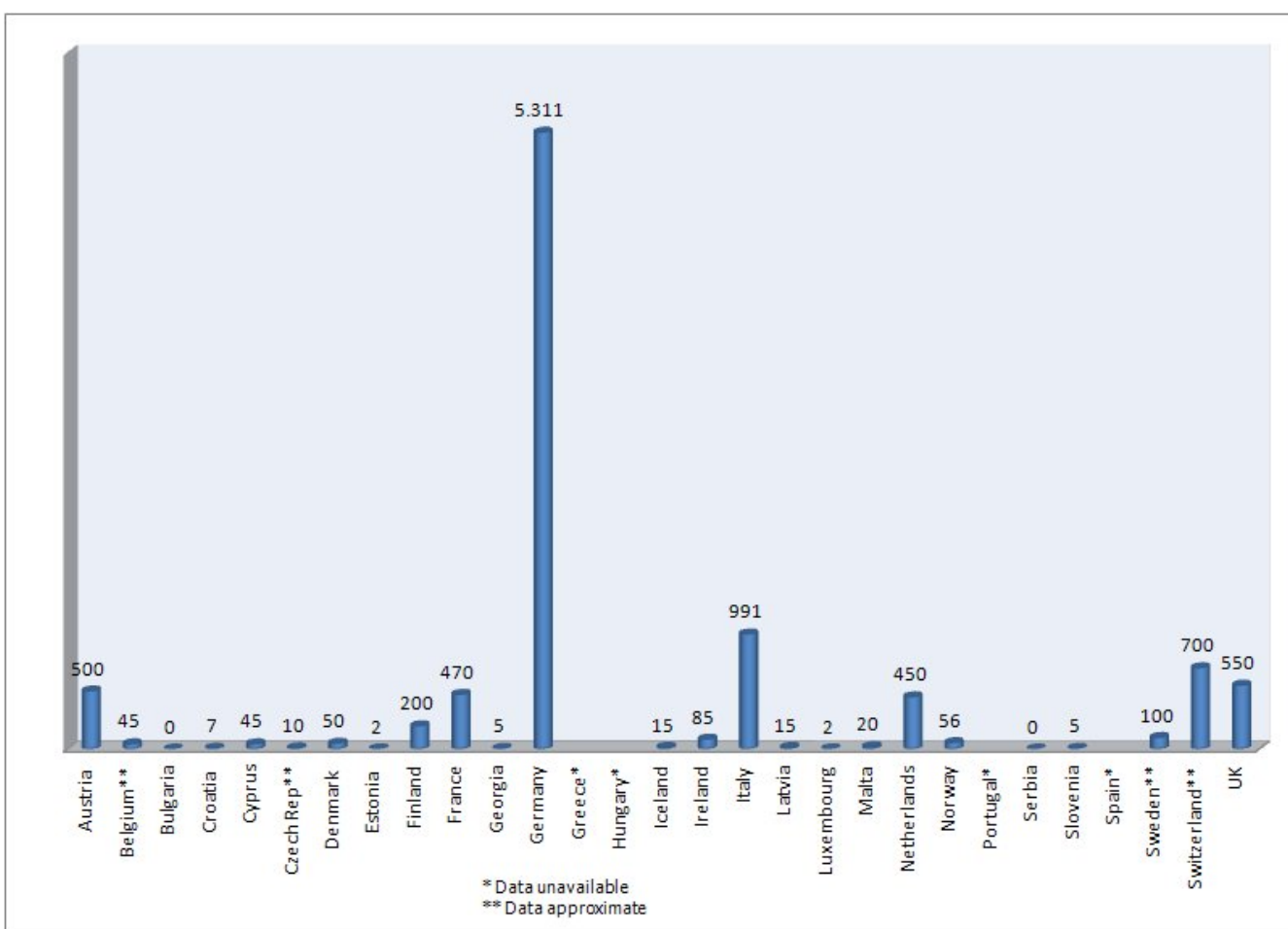


Table 2. Number of practising OTs in privat/independent practice

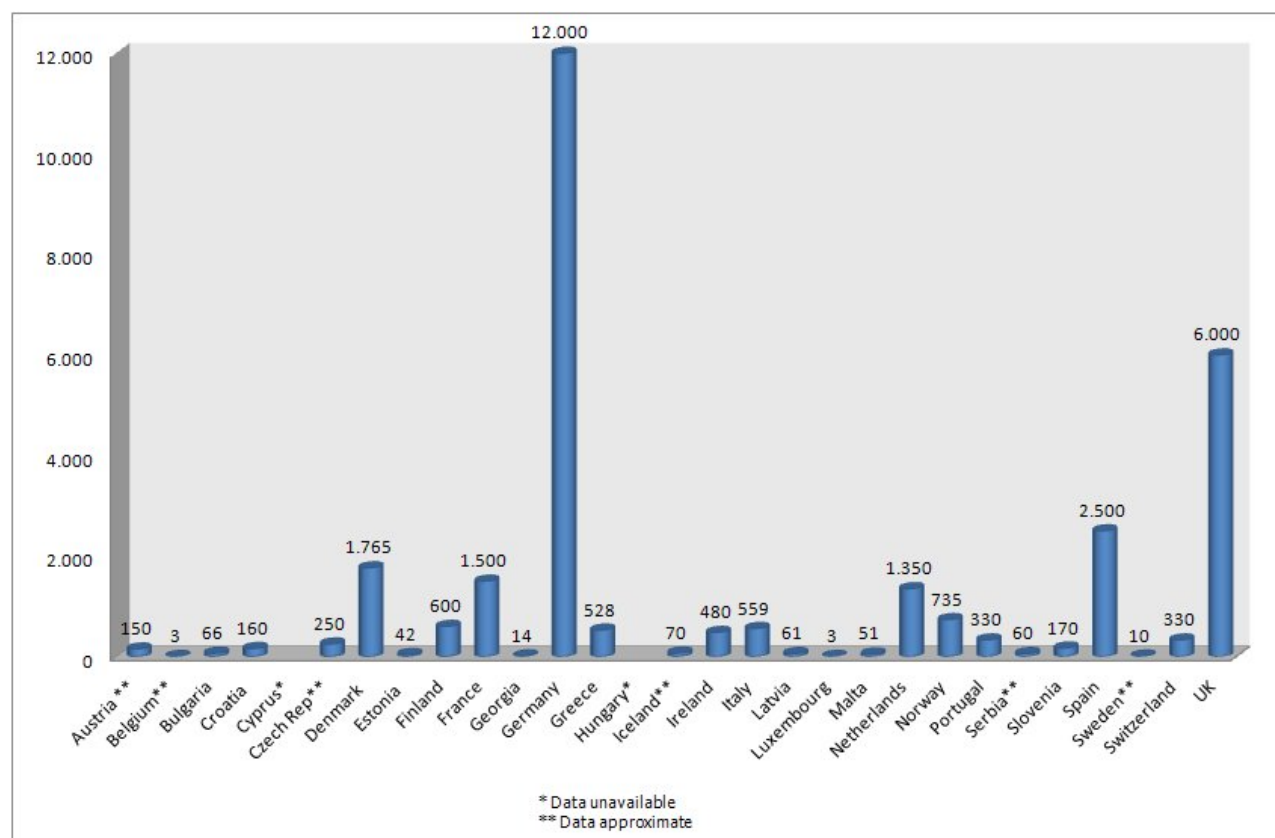


Table 3. Number of students studying OT

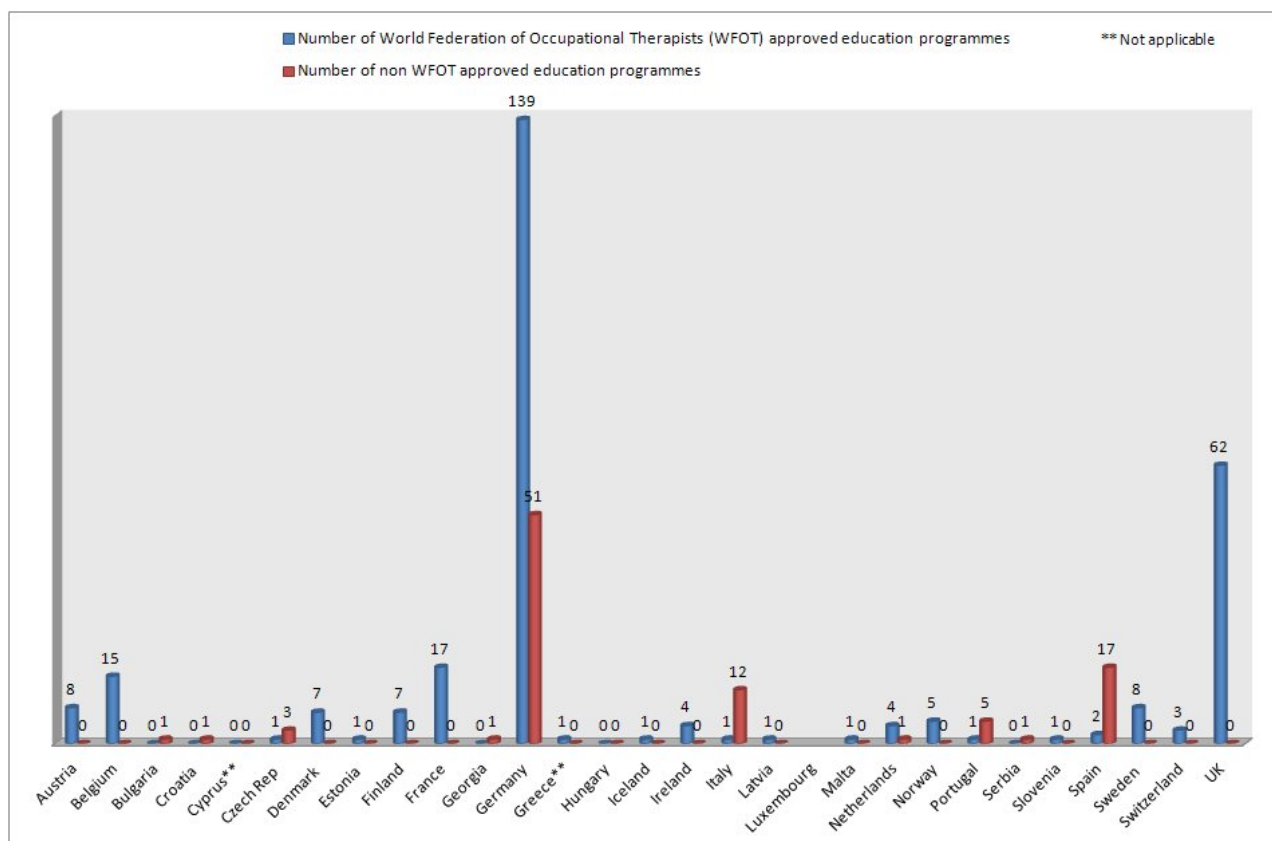


Table 4. Number of OT education programmes

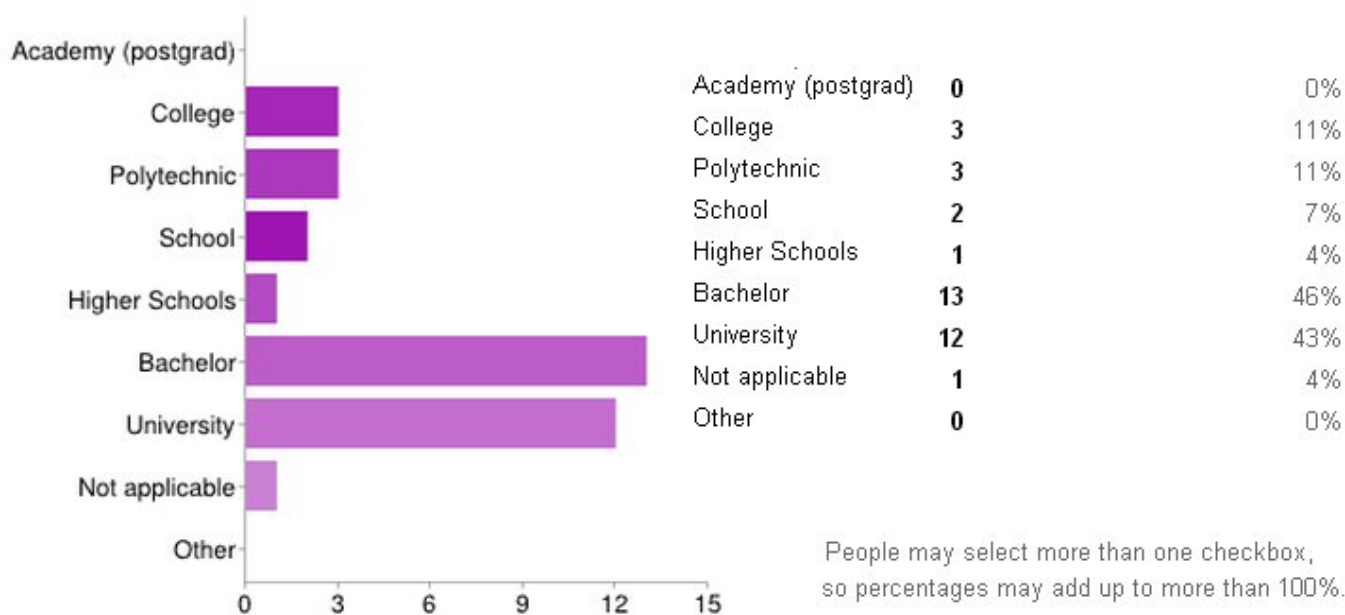
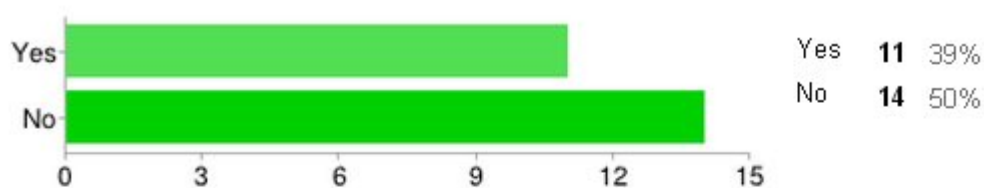
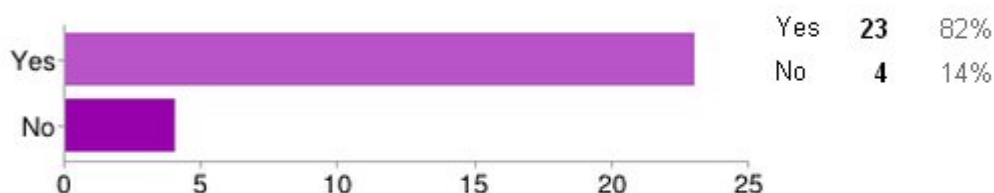


Table 5. Academic level of OT education

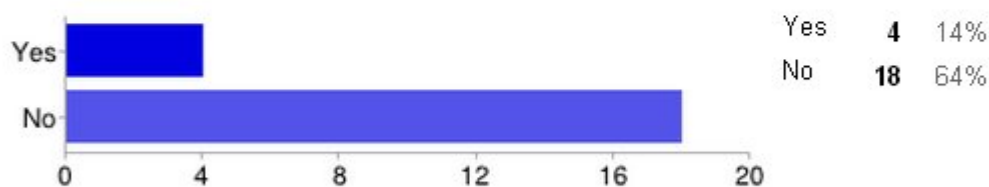
Master degree in OT

PhD for OT in other areas

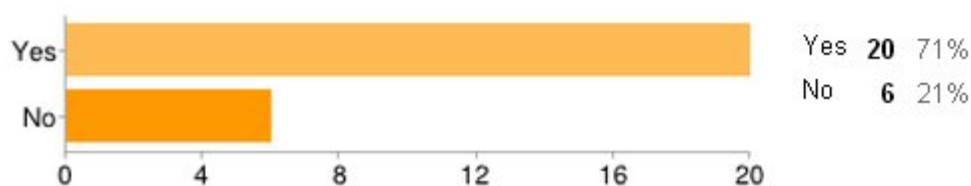


Table 6. Study opportunities for OT's

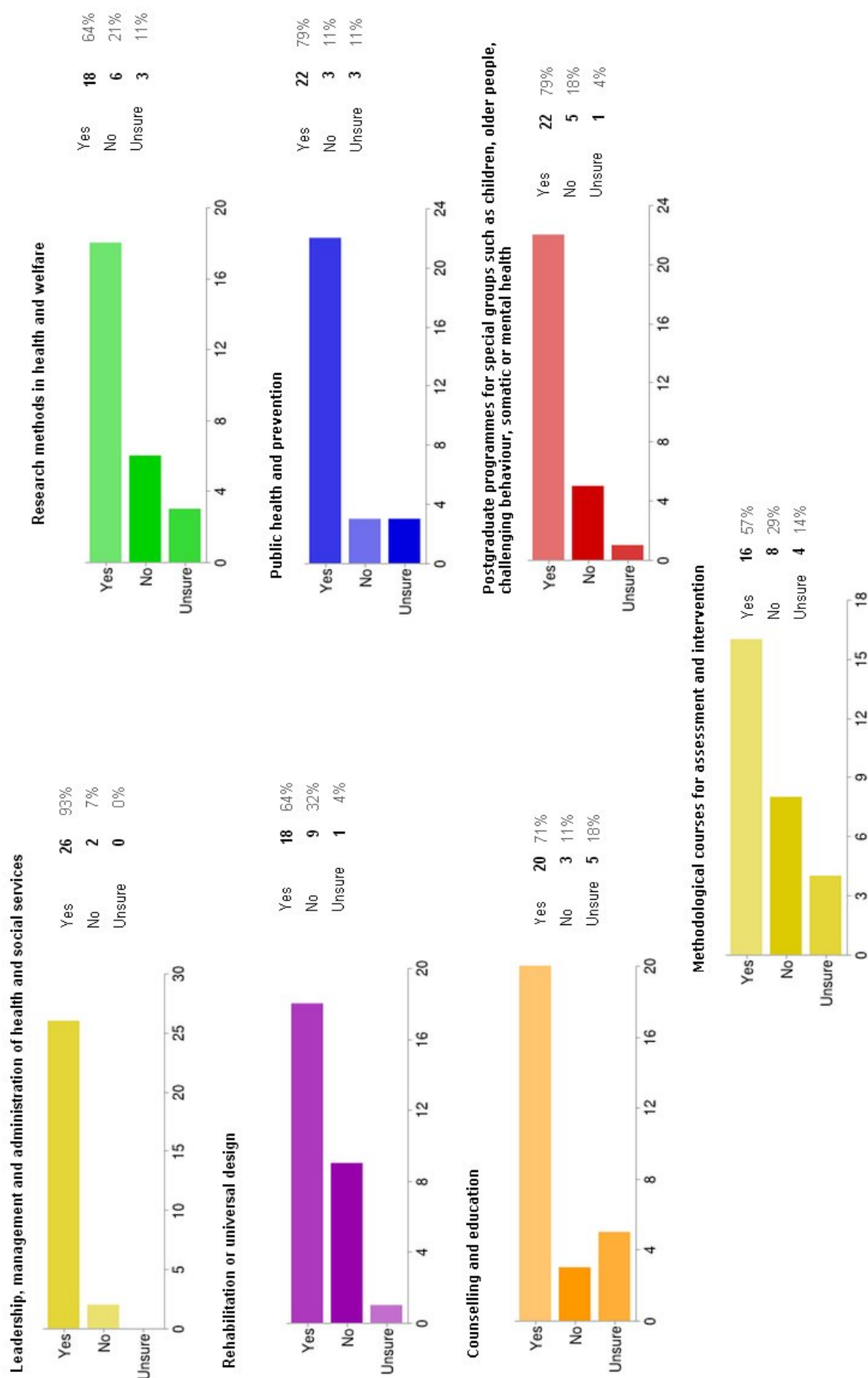


Table 7. Postgraduate basic and specialist courses offered to OT's

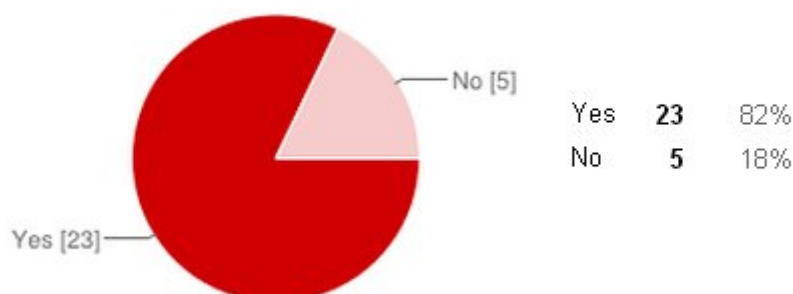


Table 8. Periodical/journal published by association

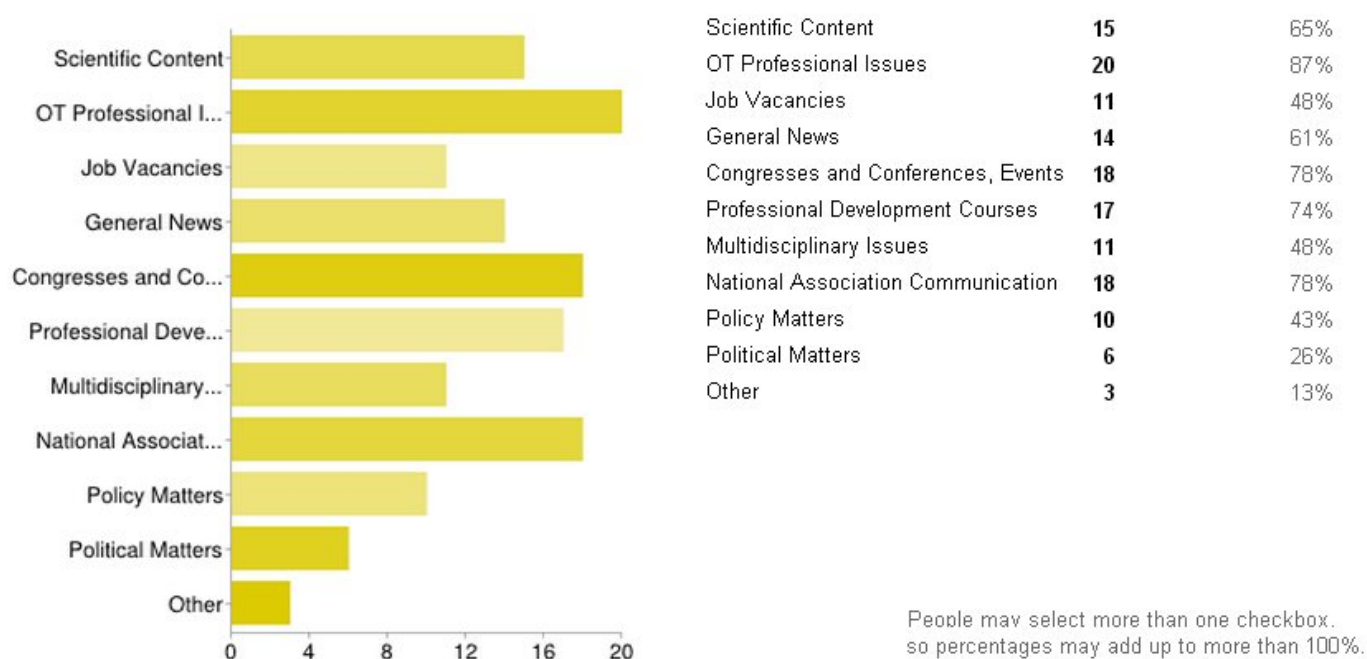


Table 9 Content of the periodical, journal

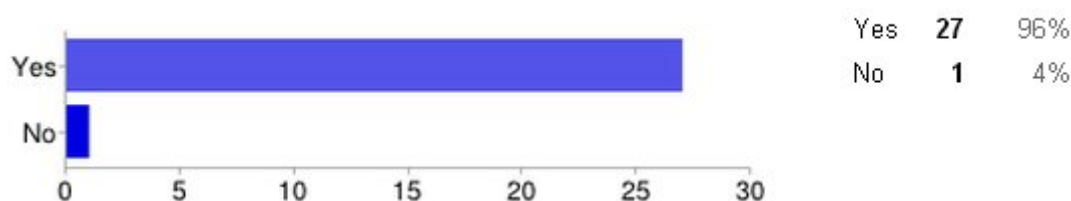


Table 10. Is the OT profession recognized by law?

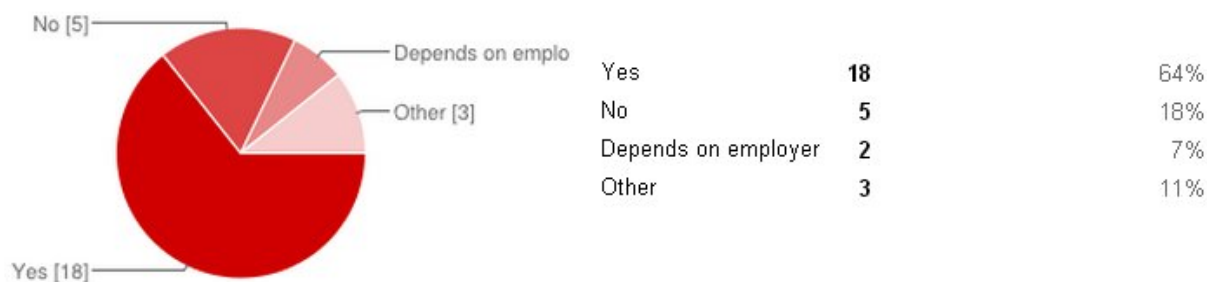


Table 11. Does OT need to be registered?

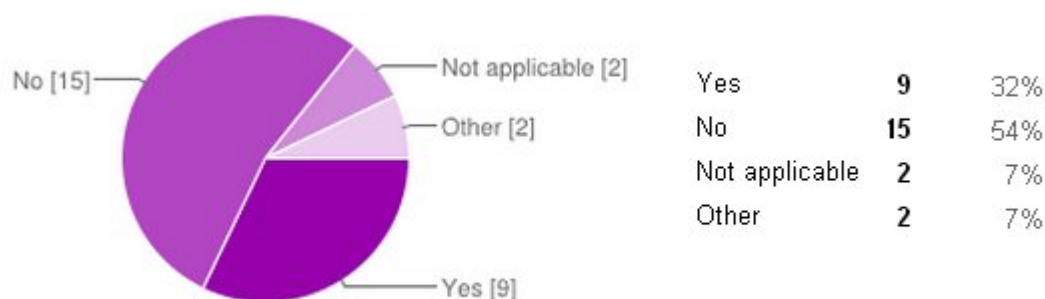


Table 12. Do OT's need to re-register/re-licence?

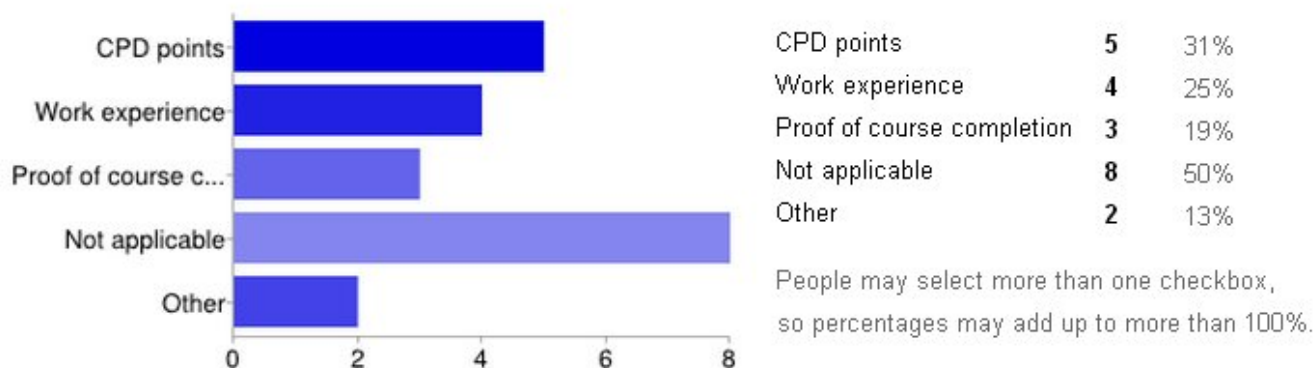


Table 12. What is necessary for re-registration/re-licencing?
