Today COTEC with a legal status as a Non-governmental organisation (NGO) represents 30 European Occupational Therapy Associations and more than 134,000 Occupational Therapists.

The aim of COTEC is to enable National Associations of Occupational Therapists in Europe to work together to:

- develop, harmonise and improve standards of professional practice and education as well as advance the theory of Occupational Therapy throughout Europe so to have distinctive profile of occupational therapy profession;
- enhance the visibility of occupational therapy in Europe by contributing solutions to health and social issues and promote inclusion, participation, health and well-being for all European citizens with occupational limitations and participation restrictions
- facilitate mobility and reduce labour market obstacles for occupational therapists. The Summary of the Occupational Therapy Profession in Europe is a document compiled and updated annually from 1986 based on information supplied by the national associations.

The Summary provides up to date statistical information about occupational therapy, the professional associations and working requirements. It also includes information about education and regulation of the profession. This information can be a valuable tool for promoting occupational therapy as well as providing information for policy makers in both health and social arenas, at national and European levels as it provides a descriptive picture of OT profession.


The Executive Committee appreciates the continuing support from COTEC Member Associations in collating information for this document and would like to present The Summary of Occupational Therapy Profession for 2014.
